| Evans - <u>Miller's Guide to Anatomy of Dog 3<sup>rd</sup> Ed.</u> | 2.1        | 2.1         | Contains helpful text and images regarding K9 anatomy, but can get through the course without this book.   |
| Dyce - <u>Textbook of Veterinary Anatomy 3<sup>rd</sup> Ed.</u>    | 3.2        | 2.7         | This book was helpful and can be used in all three anatomies throughout first year. Text and pictures for most species: equine, dog, cat, ruminants, pigs, etc.  |
