

Salmonella Contamination

AND DAIRY CALF PRODUCTION

Outbreaks of multidrug-resistant *Salmonella* in humans have been linked to dairy calves. CDC supported The Ohio State University and University of Wisconsin-Madison to study *Salmonella* contamination in dairy calf production.

The percentages of samples with *Salmonella* differed by location; many were resistant to antibiotics:



97% IN LIVESTOCK MARKET



22% IN BARN



74% IN TRAILERS



93% IN HOLDING PENS

Improving sanitation and infection control throughout calf production will reduce the spread of antibiotic-resistant *Salmonella* in people, animals, and the environment.
