

Digital Cytology Service Submission Guidelines

Clinics must complete a *digital cytology workshop prior to using this service*, please contact vetlab@cvm.osu.edu for more information.

Quick Guide

Please use this guide **after** you have already logged into our Core One portal for the first time and established your hospital/clinic email and password. [Click here](#) for instructions on how to access the online portal, if you have not done so previously.

1. Use Google Chrome or Firefox to go to:
<https://ohio.labs.tracefirst.com>
2. Log in with your hospital/clinic email and password
3. Click on **OSUVDL Portal User** link (in blue)
4. Click on the **To Be Submitted** box with the blue + sign
5. Begin typing OSU in the Receiving lab box and click on **OSU VMC Clinical Laboratories** from the options listed
6. Click **Animal/Group** at the bottom left
 - Fill in the pet name (Last/First) in the **Number/Name** box
 - Fill in **Species/Breed/Sex** (begin typing breed and options will populate)
 - Fill in **Age**
 - Fill in **Clinical History, Clinical Diagnosis, Relevant Treatment**
 - Click blue **Save** button in lower right
7. Click **Add Specimen Type** to all **Animal/Groups** and add specimen details
 - Type Digital Image for **Specimen Type and Transport Medium**
 - Type DC. Digital Submission (Y2033) in **Request Tests** box. This will autofill once you start typing digital image
 - Click **Save**
8. Select **Add/Manage Attachments** at the end of the light gray bar to add images
 - Choose **File**, upload image, preview image, go back to **Submission** and select **Save**
 - You will need to repeat these steps for every image you want to submit
 - There is a maximum of 15 images per case, and each site must be a separate submission
9. Review submission information, make any corrections, then click **Complete Submission**

How do we submit sample requests?

- Clinics should submit sample requests through the VMC CoreOne portal (<https://ohio.labs.tracefirst.com>). It can be set to send an email notification when results are ready.

How and when will I receive results?

- Turn-around time is 2 hours, Monday through Friday for samples submitted prior to 3 p.m., and by 10 a.m. on the next business day after a weekend or holiday; Results will be available through the Core One laboratory portal.

What is the cost of digital cytology & how do we pay?

- Cost = \$40 per site
- Your clinic's account will be invoiced by the Veterinary Medical Center.
